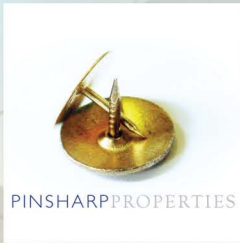

Anvil Cottage was built in 1894 by a local blacksmith as a home for his family.

This very attractive, traditional stone-built cottage has recently been extensively renovated to a detailed and thoroughly thought out high specification. The standard now represents very comfortable and luxuriously sleek boutique style accommodation.

The accommodation comprises a well-appointed, fitted kitchen with built-in fridge/freezer, dishwasher, washing machine, microwave and ceramic hob and oven. There is also a breakfast area, which seats four.

The dining room, which faces south, has generous seating for four and overlooks a well-maintained landscaped garden.

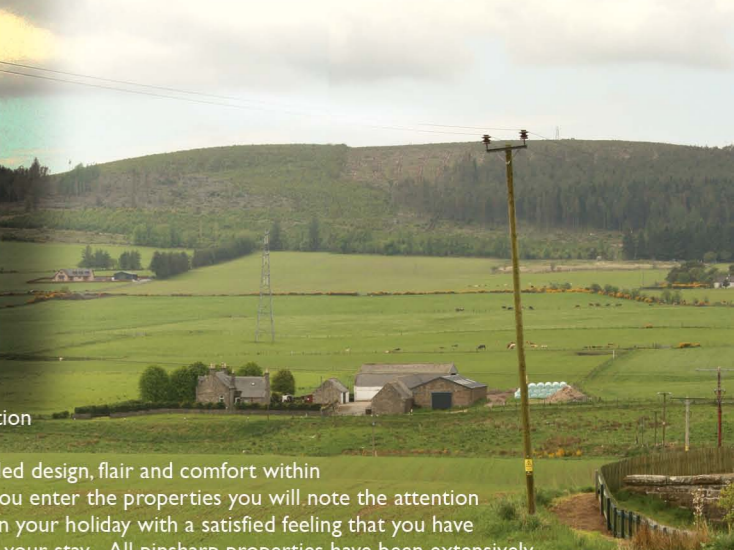
The lounge area, a light and airy space, provides a warm and intimate atmosphere thanks to the wood-burning stove and the comfortable, inviting sofas.
